- 1. Be at least 18 years of age.**
- 2. Have legal identification with your current address.**
- 3. Be able and willing to spend the time and money necessary to provide the training, medical treatment and proper care for the pet.**
- 4. Understand that the Auburn Valley Humane Society reserves the right to deny the adoption of any pet for any reason.**

Animal guardianship is a major responsibility, and one that should not be taken lightly.
